Worship Music This Week:

The prelude is a medley of four songs that talk about the name of Jesus: Glorify Thy Name, Bless His Holy Name, In the Name of the Lord, and The Majesty and Glory of Your Name.

The music during communion today is from Chris Tomlin's *Adore* album, arranged for solo piano. Lyrics for *A Christmas Alleluia*: "Alleluia, Alleluia, Christ the Savior or the world He has come. Alleluia, Alleluia to the highest name of all, Alleluia. The heavens roar, the angels sing, all glory to our God and King O night divine forevermore, Alleluia. You're the highest name of all, Alleluia."

Words for the chorus of *Adore*: "Come let us adore, oh come let us adore Him, The Lord, worship Christ the Lord; let all that is within us adore." One of the verses says: "Wise men bring their treasures, shepherds bow low, angel voices sing of peace on earth. What have I to offer to heaven's King; I will bring my life, my love, my all."

The closing hymn, *To God be the Glory*, was written by Fanny Crosby in the late 19th century. It was very popular in England when it was new, and became popular in this country when Billy Graham began to use the song as one of the theme hymns during his crusades.
