Worship Music this Week:

The three anthems that the congregation voted to hear again today, which is the last day the choir will be in the loft until September, are:

10,000 Reasons (Bless the Lord), was written and released in 2012 by British singer/songwriter Matt Redman and a Swedish friend, Jonas Mirin. They said they had Psalm 103 in mind while they were collaborating, in which David lists many reasons why his heart was full of worship for God; He forgives our sins, heals our diseases, redeems our lives from the pit, crowns us with love and compassion, satisfies our desires and gives righteousness and justice. So Redman and Myrin made a list of their own, noting they were barely scratching the surface of God's worth. "The point behind the song is this," explained Redman: "If you wake up one morning and you cannot think of a reason to bring God some kind of offering of thanks or praise, then you can be sure there's something wrong at your end of the pipeline, and not His. We live beneath an unceasing flow of goodness, kindness, greatness, and holiness, and every day we're given reason after reason why Jesus is so completely and utterly worthy of our highest and best devotion."

Another interesting side note is that the title of the song was meant to echo the "10,000 years" verse of Amazing Grace. Redman explained, "We already had the '10,000 reasons' lyric in verse two; so when it came to writing verse three, and we were on the theme of eternity, the idea came to mirror that '10,000' number and at the same time give a nod to the old hymn. The refrain: Bless the Lord O my soul, O my soul; Worship His holy name. Sing like never before O my soul, I'll worship Your holy name.

If My People Will Pray is based on 2 Chronicles 7:14: If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

You Raise Me Up/Be Still My Soul is a powerful message of faith and praise, arranged by Tom Fettke. You Raise Me Up was composed in 2001 by the Irish-Norwegian duo Secret Garden (Rolf Lovland and Brendan Graham.) It was a minor hit in the UK, but when Josh Groban recorded the song in 2002, it became well-known and loved in the United States. The first verse and refrain: When I am down, and, oh, my soul, so weary, when troubles come, and my heart burdened be; then, I am still and wait here in the silence, until you come and sit awhile with me. You raise me up, so I can stand on mountains, You raise me up to walk on stormy seas; I am strong when I am on your shoulders, You raise me up to more than I can be.
