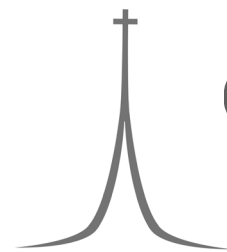

Worship Music this Week:

Now Thank We All Our God, the prelude, is a hymn that was written in 1636 by Martin Rinkart. He wrote it as a family table prayer during the Thirty Years' War. One of the texts it is based on is Isaiah 12: 4-6: In that day you will say: "Give praise to the LORD, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done, and proclaim that his name is exalted. Sing to the LORD, for he has done glorious things; let this be known to all the world. Shout aloud and sing for joy, people of Zion, for great is the Holy One of Israel among you." The first verse will be sung during the cantata *Our Father* by the choir and congregation.

The hymn *Sweet Hour of Prayer* was chosen because our focus during worship is the Lord's Prayer. The text was written by William Walford in 1845, based on Ephesians 6:18: *And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.*

The offertory solo is Albert Malotte's *The Lord's Prayer*, which he composed in 1935, based on Matthew 6:9-13. This setting is Steve Green's arrangement in which some of the prayer is spoken before the singing begins.

The refrain for the postlude, *On Eagle's Wings*, is meaningful to all of us:

And He will raise you up on eagle's wings,
Bear you on the breath of dawn,
Make you to shine like the sun,
And hold you in the palm of His Hand.

Fourth of July Festivities!

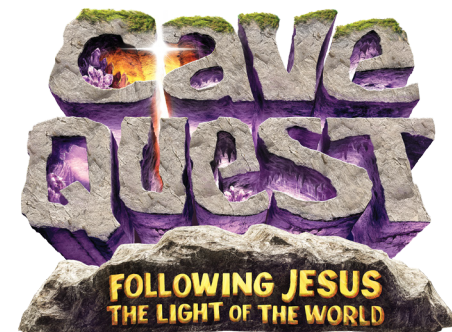
Monday, July 4th at 7pm
