## **Worship Music this Week**

The tune for the prelude, Come, All Christians, Be Committed, was composed in 1844 by Benjamin White. There are several hymn texts that use his tune, Beach Spring, including God, Whose Giving Knows No Ending, and Loaves Were Broken, Words Were Spoken. The words for this version call for us to be committed to the service of the Lord and to tune our hearts to Him to be transformed "with life anew."

The Word in Music for World Communion Sunday, Come to the Table, Come to the Lord, encourages us to come and be blessed, to bring Him our worship and praise, and for all who are weary to find rest and be restored. The table is "God's gift of grace."

The offertory piece, Seek Ye First, was written by Karen Lafferty in 1971 after she attended a Bible study that focused on the book of Matthew. She based the first verse on Matthew 6:33: But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. The words to the first verse (#175 in our hymnal) are: "Seek ye first the kingdom of God and its righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto. Allelu, alleluia!"

The music during communion is a piano arrangement by composer Lloyd Larson that combines three separate pieces: two Chris Tomlin songs - Holy Is the Lord, which continues, . . . . "The earth is filled with His glory" and We Fall Down . . . . "We lay our crowns at the feet of Jesus. The greatness of his mercy and love at the feet of Jesus. We cry holy, hol holy, holy, holy, is the lamb." The third addition to the arrangement is Be Still and Know, taken from Psalm 46:10: Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth.

The postlude, Happy is He Whose Transgressions are Forgiven, is an original composition by Jon Spong based on Psalm 32:1: Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, Whose sin is covered.
