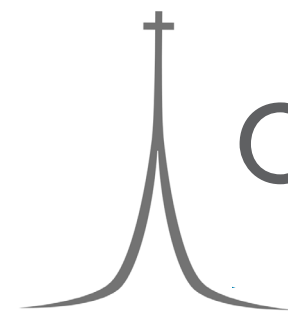

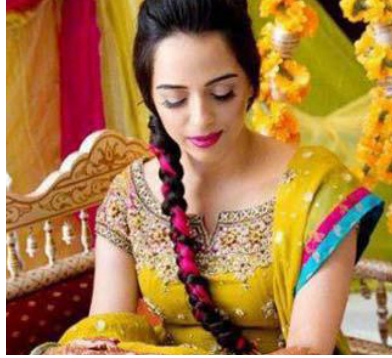

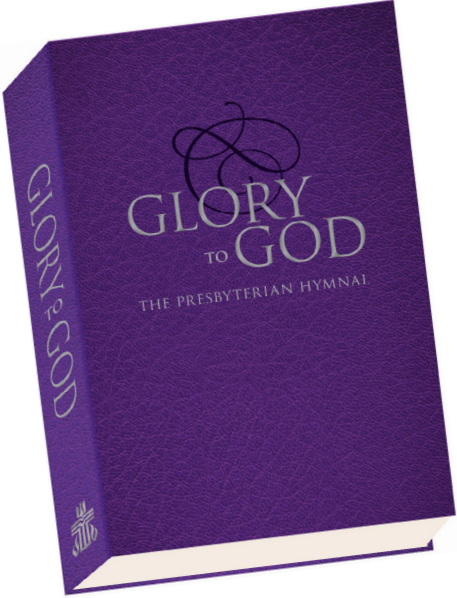
Ministry Group Speaker Series: Our Pakistani Neighbors: Hearing Their Stories
