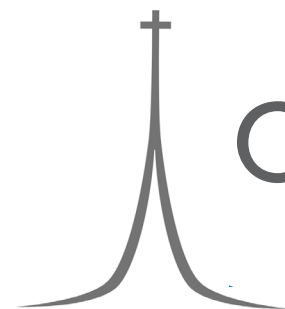

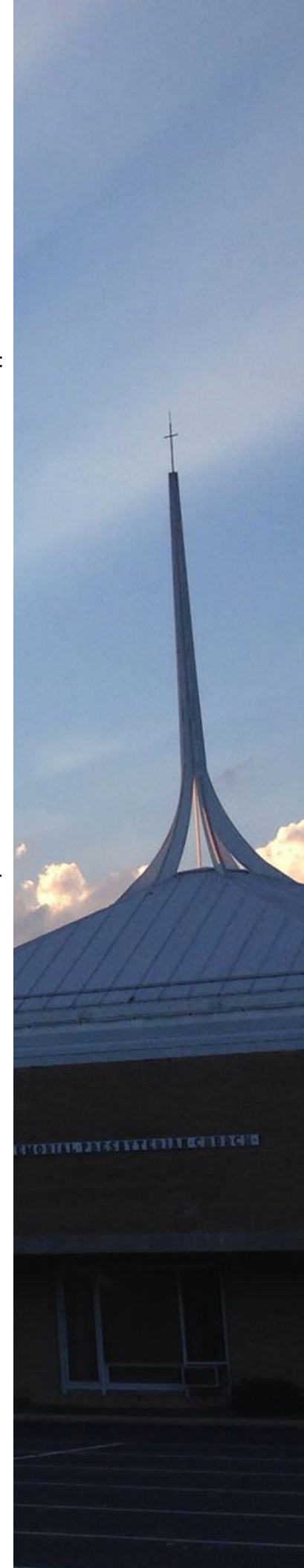
**Common Prayer of Confession
