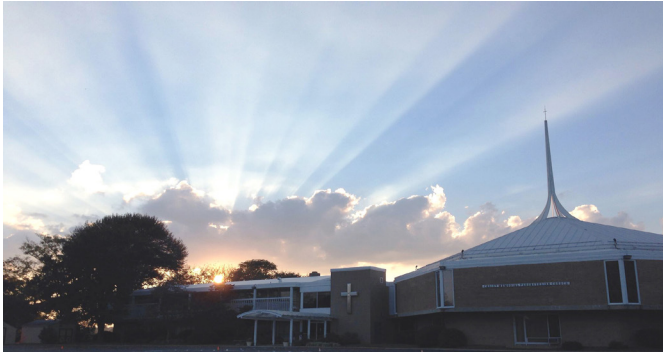

LOGOS is an intergenerational ministry designed to nurture children and youth into a committed faith relationship with God through Jesus Christ and to prepare them for a lifetime of Christian discipleship. Here at CMPC, our LOGOS program is a ministry that meets on Wednesday evenings from October-March and is open to all from preschoolers-12th grade. The LOGOS Program consists of four parts: Family Time (where LOGOS participants share a meal with their 'table parents'), Bible Time (a time for Bible Study), Recreation (fun!), and Worship Arts (e.g., choir, handbell choir, interpretive Scripture readings). This year for our annual LOGOS musical, we wanted to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the Reformation, and also recognize CMPC's 30th anniversary of LOGOS. We revised the script to "Martin and the Doors" so that the setting would be various parts of LOGOS at CMPC, and the characters would be the children in our LOGOS program. Throughout our rehearsals, we have learned about Martin Luther, five of the "great truths" penned in his theses, and the impact he had on reformed theology.

For April's GIFT (Generations in Faith Together) event, Christ Memorial Presbyterian Church will again be sponsoring a meal packaging event through the Rise Against Hunger organization. Rise Against Hunger is an international hunger relief non-profit organization that coordinates the packaging and distribution of food and other life-changing aid to people in developing nations. The cost is \$0.29/meal, so the total cost for our 20,000 meal event is \$5,800. CMPC's Mission Committee is funding a portion of the effort, and we are hoping to raise the balance of funds through donations.
