How Majestic Is Your Name, the prelude, was composed by Christian artist Michael W. Smith in 1981 and first recorded by Sandy Patti. The song will also be heard during one section of today's Word in Music.

Today is Baptism of the Lord Sunday. The hymn after the sermon, *Baptized in Water*, is offered in recognition of Christ's baptism in the river Jordan. When the heavens opened, the Holy Spirit came down as a dove, and the voice of God said: *You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased.* (Psalm 2:7)

The closing hymn, *God, Be the Love to Search and Keep Me,* is a 21st century adaptation of a traditional Celtic prayer, composed by Richard B. Colligan in 2004. Following each verse, we sing "O Christ, surround me" twice.

The text for the postlude, *All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name*, was written by Edward Perronet, a minister at an independent church in Canterbury, England in 1779. The music for the tune in our hymnal was composed by Oliver Holden in 1793.

#### **FISH Retreat**


