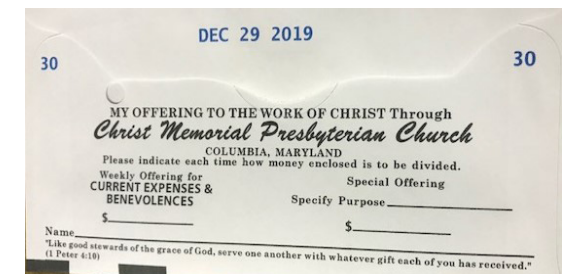
### FISH Retreat
