Worship Music this Week:

The prelude, You Are My All in All, is arranged in the setting of Pachelbel's Canon in D. The arranger, Marilynn Ham, is Artist-in-Residence and Assistant Professor of Music at Bethel College in Indiana. She teaches applied piano in sacred and classical repertoire, and is a nationally-recognized arranger, sacred concert pianist, recording artist, and workshop clinician.

The Word in Music is an arrangement of two old hymns, *Whispering Hope*, written by Septimus Winner in 1868, and *Wonderful Peace*, composed by W. D. Cornell in 1877. Composer/arranger Joel Raney melded the two songs masterfully in this arrangement.

The hymn after the sermon today, *Savior, Like a Shepherd Lead Us*, was written by Dorothy Ann Thrupp in London. She wrote many hymns for children. This one appeared, unsigned, in her collection Hymns for the Young in 1836. The music was composed specifically for the text by William B. Bradbury, who gave the tune his surname. Bradbury is also the composer of *Jesus Loves Me*.
