#### Worship Music this Week:

Come, All Christians, Be Committed, the prelude, was composed by Eva Brown Lloyd. The words: "Come, all Christians, be committed to the service of the lord; make your lives for him more fitted, tune your hearts with one accord. Come into His courts with gladness, each his sacred vows renew; turn away from sin and sadness, be transformed with life anew." (Broadman Press, 1966) The second verse refers to joyfully offering our God-given time and talents to the service of our Lord.

The communion music, *Simple Gifts*, was composed by Joseph Brackett Jr., an American songwriter, author, and elder in the Shaker church, who wrote the song in 1848. Research reveals that his people were as vigorous in their worship as they were in their work, and that this piece was called a dancing song. The words written by him are said to be dancing instructions for when they used the song in worship. His original words, include "come 'round right", when the people were to end up in their original position. The tune has been used for several hymns. In our current hymnal, it is titled *I Danced in the Morning*, telling the story of Christ's life. Brackett's original words: "Tis' the gift to be simple tis' the gift to be free tis' the gift to come down where you ought to be; and when we find ourselves in the place just right, t'will be in the valley of love and delight. When true simplicity is gained, to bow and to bend we shant be ashamed; to turn, turn will be our delight til by turning, turning we come 'round right." (E.C. Shirmer, current publisher)
