Preschool Sign In:

Pick Up Procedures:

Just a reminder that when you arrive to pick up your child from their fun day at preschool, please wait outside the classrooms. A teacher will open the door and dismiss each child individually to their parent. Please be sure to stand far enough back from the door that the teacher can see all those that have arrived for

pick up. In our wonderful large space it can become quite noisy at pick up. Please help us make dismissal run smoothly by trying to keep all voices lower and please no running.
